










What is CERIC?

- A distributed research infrastructure (ERIC) in Central Europe;
- Established by the EC implementing decision in June 2014;
- Open access (a single evaluation system);
- Complementary instruments in the fields of advanced materials, biomaterials and nanotechnology





CERIC - a distributed facility

Rationale:

- To optimise resources
- To optimise use (trans-national access)
- To increase quality (joint research, knowledge sharing)

Funding:

- Funding for the Central administration provided by IT
- Each country has to fund its own infrastructure, contributed in kind

Important:

No preparatory phase

RI & Joint RD activities: regional ERDF, cross-border

ERDF

Open access: all ERDF (limited to outreach, pilots, IL)

Training: all ERDF, ESF

Coordination, outreach, communication, TT:

Mainly transnational ERDF

Examples:

Regional ERDF, national

- CERIC (Int): joint RD (IT national, all with in-kind contributions)
- Surface physics (CZ): support to users (national), RI call open (ERDF)
- NMR (SI): support to CERIC activities (national)
- Solaris (PL): constructed with ERDF, a call for RIs open (ERDF)
- Microscopy (RO): ca. 80% of RI cofunded with the ERDF

Transnational ERDF: Central Europe (submitted)

Cross-border ERDF: SI-AT (RIS and RD; submitted), SI-IT (in preparation)
