




Network

The GÉANT network interconnects research, education and innovation communities worldwide, with secure, high-capacity networks.


We design, plan, build and operate the large-scale, high-performance GÉANT network that connects European NRENs to each other and the rest of the world for sharing, accessing and processing the high data volumes generated by research and education communities and for testing innovative technologies and concepts.



Interconnecting Europe's NRENs over a 500Gb highly-resilient pan-European backbone.


NRENs serve 50 million users at 10,000 institutions across Europe.

Where can I use eduroam?

Whether you're moving across campus or spending time studying or working at another research and education institution, eduroam gives you seamless internet connectivity.

What does it cost?

Thanks to global agreement, the eduroam Wi-Fi roaming service is free-of-charge to users.

More than 10,000 eduroam hotspots are available at universities, research centres, academies, many schools, and other research and education institutions in more than 100 territories around the world. As eduroam grows, more and more hotspots are appearing in additional places such as libraries, museums and public spaces such as railway stations and coffee shops.



eduGAIN – enabling worldwide access

What does eduGAIN do?

Allows students and researchers to securely access thousands of educational services world wide using single sign-on.

How eduGAIN works

eduGAIN is an aggregating, signing and distribution service to aid in the sharing of identity attributes between identity federations.

How much does it cost?

eduGAIN is free to use for the identity federations that are members and free for the end users that are part of institutions announced in eduGAIN.



- Enables teams to be created and managed flexibly and securely.

- Single Point of Management for community managers to add and remove users and services.
