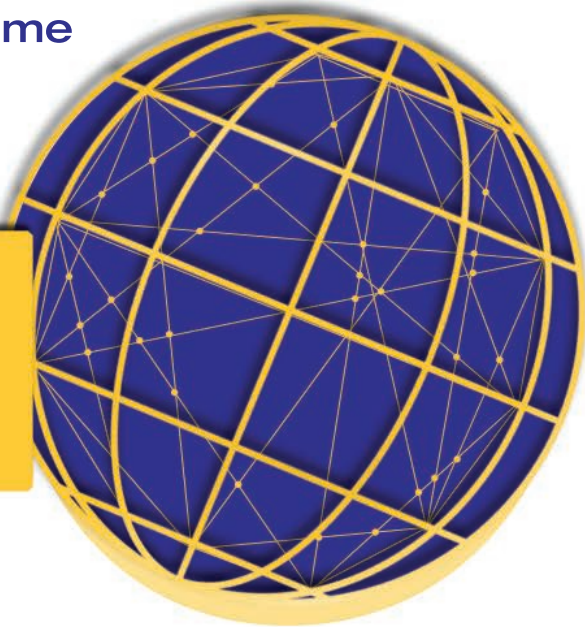

What are Research Infrastructures in Horizon 2020?

Research infrastructures are facilities, resources and services that are used and made accessible to **conduct research and foster innovation**.

Including:



major scientific equipment; knowledge-based resources, archives or scientific data; data and computing systems and communication networks; and any other infrastructure of a unique nature essential to achieve excellence in research and innovation.

What can be funded in Horizon 2020?

- Development and sustainability of new **pan-European** research infrastructures
- **Integrating** and **opening** Research Infrastructures of European interest
- e-infrastructures
- **Free** transnational and virtual **access** to research infrastructures

What is the Research Infrastructures ecosystem?

The RICH network is part of Research Infrastructures ecosystem and the main gateway for research infrastructures and e-infrastructures **funding, policy** and **governance** information. Diverse actors and stakeholders are involved: European, national and regional policy-makers, users, managers, operators and project coordinators.

A number of features are addressed: from financial instruments and possible synergies of Horizon 2020 funds with the **Smart Specialization Strategies** to governance of research infrastructures or **global dimension** of research infrastructures.
